Issued at 9:00 PM today, January 23, 2026

Synopsis: At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (formerly "ADA") was estimated based on all available data at 560 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.8°N, 131.4°E). Northeast Monsoon affecting Luzon and Visayas.



Forecast: Cloudy skies with light rains will be experienced over Bulusan volcano.
