**SYNOPSIS:** At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (formerly "ADA") was estimated based on all available data at 765 km East of General Santos City, South Cotabato (5.8°N, 132.0°E). Shear Line affecting the eastern section of Mindanao. Northeast Monsoon affecting the rest of the country.
