**SYNOPSIS:** At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data 150 km Northwest of Bacnotan, La Union or 125 km West Southwest of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (17.6°N, 119.3°E). Southwest Monsoon affecting Palawan, Visayas, and Mindanao.
